

## **Commander's Exclusive**

Greetings members of the American Legion Neal E. Fonger Post 179. The month of February has been a very challenging. Many issues have come up and along with that there have been many rumors. I would like to start by defining what rumors/hearsay: the spreading of lies or untruths, or ("a statement or report current without known authority for its truth" Merriam-Webster). So, with that being said allow me to squash one rumor before it gets out of hand. The post and the clubroom are not the same. The American Legion does not recognize the "clubroom" as part of the legion. The Legion only recognizes the American Legion Neal E. Fonger Post 179. American Legion Post 179, Neal E. Fonger is not being closed. The clubroom hours have been modified, temporarily, for restructuring and is **not closing**. Furthermore, in the post by-laws, Article 2, Section 1 it says "the government and management of the posts are entrusted to the "post executive committee," except that the management of the clubroom itself shall be entrusted to the clubroom committee, and the management of the real estate shall be entrusted to the building committee. Both committees shall read a written report to the membership at all post meetings. A written report shall also be submitted to the executive committee monthly, whether or not the meeting is being held" No where in this article does it state the commander of the post or bar manager will govern or make decisions concerning the clubroom. Article 5 Post Management Committee in section 2: Clubroom Committee: shall be charged to direct the operation of the posts clubroom, in accordance with the clubroom rules, and regulations which shall be adopted or reviewed, and readopted annually at the first committee meeting following the election and installation of post officers. The failure of the committee to review, and or readopt its rules as required here and shall not invalidate any rules or regulation previously adopted by the committee.

The clubroom committee shall be composed, in part, of three (3) elected legionnaires. Also serving on this committee shall
