American Legion Post 179 is starting a new program effective April 1st, 2019. All members who attend 75% of the monthly meetings (that is 9 out of 12 in a full calendar year) will receive a \$5 discount on their membership for the next year. Due to this program starting in April of this year members will be required to attend 7 out of the remaining 9 meetings to qualify. Tracking will be done according to the sign-in sheets for each meeting so make sure to sign your name clearly in order to receive credit for your attendance. 


