We are continuing our efforts with quarterly blood drives and the planning for the Veterans Day Student Education Program is in full swing by the committee.
- ◆ Communication: One of the goals for communication is to establish a Public Relations Committee. I would like to ask for volunteers at this time to serve on this committee.
- ◆ **Finances:** Due to the resignation of the elected Finance Officer a new Finance Officer has been elected and will be able to give a report at the meeting.
- ◆ Oversight Committee: I will be naming the individuals for this committee by August 31st, 2019. This committee will meet two times annually; in the Fall and Spring to review, investigate, and make recommendations pertaining to the strategic plan.

I hope by providing this update everyone is aware that we are working to reach our goals for the upcoming year. Every member is invited to the Commander Coffee Hour on July 13th, 2019 from 8 a.m to 9 a.m. There is no agenda just a good conversation with members about what matters to the post.


