A: The American Legion (National) sends out initial dues renewal notices with a return envelope to your home post. Once the adjutant has renewed your dues then you are removed from the renal notice list. Sometimes if you renew close to the date they send out another wave of renewal notices you can get a rental notice even though you may have recently paid your dues.
